March is the most exciting month of the year for the Corning-Painted Post Sports Hall of Fame. All the time, effort and work that goes into the upcoming Induction Weekend all comes to this month on Induction Weekend, March 15-16.

The Board of Directors is proud to present the Class of 2024 that will be inducted into the Hall of Fame at the ceremony on the afternoon of Saturday, March 16th at the Corning Museum of Glass. Prior to that, on the evening of Friday, March 15th at the VFW on Baker Street, they will be hosting a buffet dinner catered by the Woodhouse Stadium Grill beginning at 6 p.m. This social gathering on Friday night is open to the public and free of charge.

Ten new members from six different categories make up the Class of 2024. From the baseball diamond comes Rocky Myers, an East High and Alfred State standout along with Ryan Walker who shined at C-PP High School and St. Bonaventure University in both baseball and track.

They will be joined by Brandon Griffin and Pete Knutsen from the gridiron. Brandon is the All-Purpose yardage leader in C-PP High School history while Pete was an All-State, First-Team selection as an offensive lineman.

Longtime coaches Geoff Waksmunski and Ed Gigliotti will be inducted along with C-PP High School track stars Katelyn Butler and Wynndham Curtis. Katelyn went on to star at Appalachian State and Wynndham at Cornell University.

Rounding out the Class of 2024 from C-PP High School are Neena Merola who was a solid contributor to the Syracuse University women's lacrosse team and Eric Donovan, a standout bowler for the Notre Dame College of Ohio.

The Board of Directors will also honor C-PP High School student-athlete seniors Angelina McKane, Sarah Lawson, AJ Thomas and Brody Wolfe as George Bacalles Memorial Winners.

The C-PP Sports Hall of Fame has also learned that 2020 Inductee (that actually took place in 2022) Scott Doan, who was inducted in the bowling category, will be enshrined later this month into the Tioga County Sports Hall of Fame in the same category.
