September marks the beginning of a new 'season' for the Corning-Painted Post Sports Hall of Fame, with the first monthly meeting of the Board of Directors. They will meet each month working towards a number of things with the most important being the 49 th Annual Induction Ceremony which will be held on the second or third weekend of March at the Corning Museum of Glass.

The Board of Directors is currently accepting nominations for individuals for possible induction into the Hall of Fame. A sponsor can find the guidelines for

nominating someone on this website. The resume can be entered right from the website, or it may be mailed to the Hall of Fame at the following address:

The deadline for resumes for any nominee for the Class of 2025 is October 31, 2024. Either submitted to the website by that date or postmarked prior to the deadline date. All resumes must include name, address, phone number and email address for both the sponsor and the candidate. Any resumes received after the deadline will be kept on file and be considered for the Class of 2026.

If someone has sent a resume to the Board of Directors in the past and the candidate wasn't selected for induction, send any updates before the deadline as the BOD keeps all resumes on file for at least five years. All resumes should include as much information as you can possibly gather. Too much information is so much better than not enough information.

Another prominent date for the Hall of Fame will be Sunday, December 1, 2024. That's the date of the Hall of Fame fundraiser that will be held at Crystal Lanes. It's the only fundraiser the Hall of Fame has for the year. It's a four-person, 9-pin no-tap event that is geared for fun and not really competition.
