Each year the Corning-Painted Post Sports Hall of Fame, Board of Directors honors four senior student-athletes from the Corning School District with the George Bacalles Memorial Award.

The award, selected by a panel of the high school head coaches in every sport, honors these student-athletes that have demonstrated outstanding performance as a member of at least one school athletic team and also show exemplary character and citizenship with a solid academic performance.

This year's winners of the Bacalles Awards are soccer standout Lilia Mack, volleyball and lacrosse star Gracee Work along with outstanding diver Brandon Jardin-Reed from the swim team who also was a standout on the Hawks football team, and Zuri Ruffin, the MVP of the track and field team.

These four student-athletes will be honored at the 49 th Annual C-PP Sports Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony that will be held on Saturday, March 7 th at 1 p.m. at the Corning Museum of Glass.
